A Full CCTV System is installed inside and outside of the Licenced Premises covering all areas of the Pub, Which is monitored by an outside central control room.
Storage of the CCTV Images is kept for 60 days. All staff are trained on the law that legally they cannot sell alcohol to persons under the age of 18, However we adopt a think 21 policy. Authorised/approved forms of ID will be requested when necessary - Photo Pass Scheme, Photo Card Driving Licence or Passport.

c) Public safety

Full CCTV System installed.
The premises is well lit inside and outside. All fire exits and Exit Routes are clearly labeled and illuminated.
All fire fighting equipment is onsite and serviced yearly.
All Emergency Lighting is tested Monthly
All Fire systems are serviced yearly and tested monthly.
We have a first aider on site at all times, along with first aid kits.
Full Public liability Insurance held.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Signage is erected requesting patrons to leave the premises in an orderly manner and respect its neighbors
A Sound Limiter is fitted to manage noise levels when Live Music is being played
Alcohol is not served to anyone under the age of 18

Annex 1- Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

(1) Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions.

(2) The first condition is that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

(3) The second condition is that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

MANDATORY LICENSING CONDITIONS ORDER 2010

1.

(1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children—

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—

- (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—

- (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
- (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises

which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

2.

The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

3.

The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

4.

(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol,

identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

5.

The responsible person shall ensure that-

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-

(i) beer or cider: ½ pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Children allowed on premises between 11:00 and 21:00 except in restaurant until 23:00. Children not permitted in bars. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

- External areas to be closed at 23.00hrs
- Advisory signage to be posted
- Entry to premises to be restricted to before 23.00hrs
- Staff supervision of patrons arriving and leaving the premises
- Appropriate enforcement by the establishment in the event of unruly behaviour being witnessed
- Other measures described in the section on Prevention of Crime and Disorder

Reason: The Sub-Committee was concerned about disturbance to local residents as set out in observations made by the Council's Environmental Health Officer. However, the Sub-Committee took into account the need to allow flexibility under the new licensing regime and under its own policy and that the lack of complaints at present indicates that the premises is well managed.

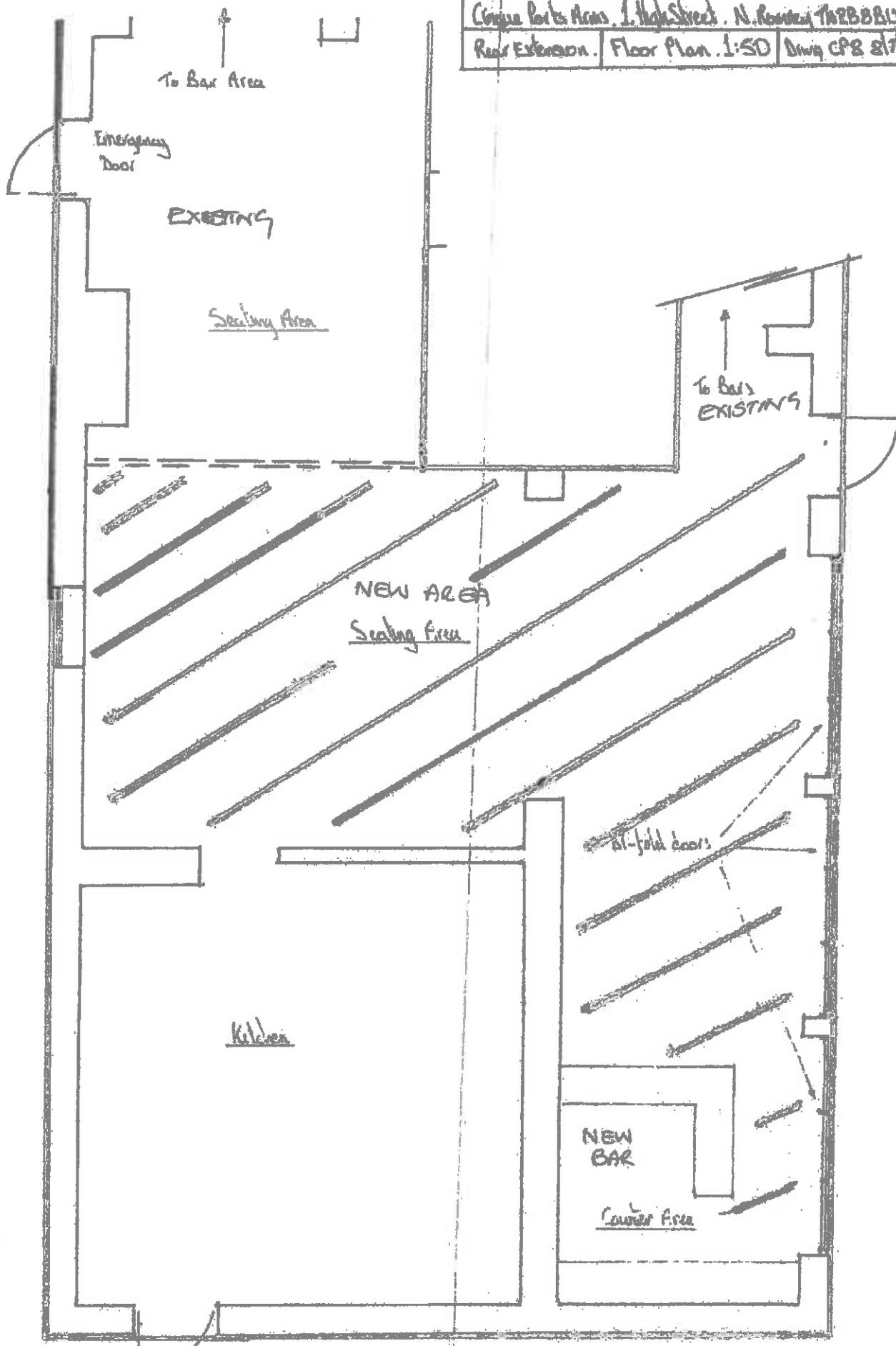

Variation of Premises Licence

Dear Shepway Licensing/Planning/Environmental Services

We acknowledge your previous concerns and have amended the New application to coincide with the following request:-

Sunday Music.-

This has now been removed from our application, We have listened to the concerns of the local residents and took them on board.

Environmental Services Request :-

- 1, All doors and windows are closed during live performances including DJ music.
- 2, Adequate ventilation must be provided to the premises, method must be in agreement with the local authority.
- 3, Noise limiter is to be installed within 6 weeks of the granting of the license. The noise limited must be set to a level agreed by the local authority.
- 4, A door supervisor must be in attendance for live performances including DJ music. They should also be in charge of keeping the noise from your patrons located at the front of your main entrance to a minimum.
- 5, Signs must be placed up at entrances and exits to remind your patrons to respect the neighbours and leave the site quietly.
- 6, Similar signs reminding your patrons to respect the neighbours and keep noise down to a minimum, must be put up within the designated smoking area.
