Annex 1- Mandatory Conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) Where a premises licence authorises the supply of alcohol, the licence must include the following conditions.
- (2) The first condition is that no supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (3) The second condition is that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition: door supervision

- (1) Where a premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, the licence must include a condition that each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in subsection (1) requires such a condition to be imposed-

(a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c.12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or

(b) in respect of premises in relation to-

(i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or

(ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).

- (3) For the purposes of this section-
 - (a) "security activity" means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
 - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

General - to meet all objectives

Work in partnership with authorities and organistations with a view to promoting the licensing objective, these partnerships include local authorities, police, local businesses and local people.

Full time staff will be appropriatley trained and have an understanding of responsibilites under the Licensing Act 2003.

Prevention of Crime & Disorder Operating Schedule

CCTV will be installed internally and externally and operated during hours open to the public. External lighting will be installed and maintained. If the premises opens after 23:00 on a Friday and Saturday night, SIA registered door staff will be employed at 22:00 until the premises closing time.

Public Safety Operating Schedule

If public safety is at risk a closure notice will be fully complied with. CCTV records will be available to the appropriate authorities.

Prevention of public nuisance Operating Schedule

Install noise reduction measures to the public address system and reduce the level of contollable noise.

Protection of children from harm Operating Schedule

Any person below the legal drinking age will not be served alcohol and admission may be refused. Children will not be served in the late evening.
