

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (THE DISTRICT OF FOLKESTONE & HYTHE)  
(FOLKESTONE TOWN CENTRE AND THE BAYLE PARKING ZONE) (AMENDMENT 11)  
ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The Order proposes the following restriction in the road below:

**Shared use limited waiting for 2 hours no return within 2 hours and permit holders [8am – 6pm Monday to Saturday]**

**Grace Hill:** South west side, from a point 28.4 metres north west of its junction with Rendezvous Street, north west to a point 22.9 metres south east of its junction with Shellons Street;

**Shellons Street:** Shellons Street – South east side, from a point 25 metres south west of its junction with Grace Hill, south west for a distance of 35 metres;

This would replace the current limited waiting restrictions.

**Limited waiting 2 hour no return within 2 hours [8am – 6pm Mondays to Saturdays (both days inclusive)]**

**Christ Church Road;** west side, shorted current double yellow lines to 20.5 metres from the junction with Bouverie Road West; extend the current double yellow lines outside the yard of the Radnor Arms public house by 6.6 metres

This is extending the current parking bays by 1.4 metres

**Shared use limited waiting for 1 hour no return within 2 hours and permit holders [8am – 6pm on all days]**

**Manor Road:** North east side from a point 11 metres north west from the junction with Sandgate Road for a distance of 17 metres in a north westerly direction;

This would replace the existing prohibition of waiting.

**PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME**

Roads in Folkestone; Sandgate Road at the entrance and exit of Garden House Court for 5 metres in both directions; Roads in New Romney; Craythorne Lane Both sides from the junction with Fairfield Road for a distance of 18 metres

**PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE**

Roads in Folkestone, Tram Road, both sides, entire length, Risborough Lane, both sides, between St Marks Close & Alma Road; Roads in Hythe, Horn Street, eastern side, between no. 30 and no.68.

**PARKING PLACE FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES ONLY**

Downs Road, Folkestone from a point 24.4 metres west of the junction with Canterbury Road for a distance of 6 metres; High Street, Lydd in the vicinity of no. 30; High Street, New Romney, in the vicinity of no. 28

**PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING AT ANY TIME**

Roads in St Marys Bay at the junctions with Jefferstone Lane and Maple Drive on existing no waiting at any time restrictions
