DECISION:

To provide funding of £346.19 to the above project.

Reason for decision:

Our group has been most fortunate in having been gifted a 5.5-acre woodland at Stelling Minnis. The group have been developing the site since January 2018 have already invested almost £18,000 and hundreds of hours of volunteer labour.

We do not intend to see the site overdevelop, our vision would be to have a site that is mainly focused on conservation and will maintain its stunning trees and wildlife areas.


In the future once the site has some basic amenities, we plan to offer Redbanks to small learning groups of school children, MIND, The Shed, Dementia groups and others that could enjoy this environment as well of course getting our young people under canvas enjoying the outdoor life.

We currently plan to raise and invest in the region of £40,000 over the next three years at Redbanks, installing electricity, building toilets facilities and all-weather meeting room.
