Reason for decision:		

In 2017 a survey was undertaken of Lydd Town and Coastal communities (Rochelle Saunders) which reported an 80% interest in a Dementia Café locally both at Lydd Town and Lydd Coast. Our Café is supported by the Alzheimer's Society who provide advice from their local Services Manager and also from their Support Worker who accepts referrals from our clients. Since commencing our Café in 2019 we have continued to have an increased attendance and currently five people living with dementia and their carers are attending. We also support carers who have recently lost their partner through re-location to Nursing Home provision or death. We receive visits from our local Care Navigator, Clergy, Shepway Care Line, local Admiral Nurse, Community Support Officer and have also registered our Service with Folkestone/Hythe Spotlight. Our client group were supportive of our moving to two sessions per month and state that they find the friendship and support that they receive very helpful in avoiding social isolation which is recognised as of

concern. We have also had visits from the local CCG Public/Patient Engagement Officer and have supported/advised a newly forming Dementia Café in Dover.-
