## 2. Footway and verge parking ban

2.1 Campbell Road, Hawkinge [Map 1]

Requests from resident who experiences problems with vehicles parking on vehicle crossovers in such a way that it blocks the footway.
2.2 Vinelands, Lydd [Map 2]

Persistent parking on grass verges and blocking of footway.

### 2.3 Chapel Street, Hythe [Map 3]

Persistent parking by visitors to nearby café despite DYL in place. Currently when parking on footway CEO's can only begin a DYL contravention which is often aborted when driver returns as this contravention takes time to log into the handheld.

### 2.4 Prospect Road, Hythe (near Station Road roundabout) [Map 4] <br> Vehicles ordering takeaways from nearby 'Aspendos' parking on footway. KCC advised that due to numerous underfootway utilities bollards are not an option at this location.

## 3. Waiting Restrictions (Double Yellow Lines)

### 3.1 Harvey Place (off Harvey Street, Folkestone [Map 5]

A request form the Garages team to install DYL down this narrow street to keep clear access to FHDC owned garages.
