## Animal Welfare (Licensing Of Activities Involving Animals) (England) Regulations 2018

## Grant / renewal fees

The Part A fee (non- refundable) must be paid at the time of application. This covers the cost of dealing with the application.

Part B fee is determined following the application and inspection process. Part B must be paid in full prior to the issue of a licence.

Veterinary Inspection fees, where applicable, are in addition to the Part A/B fee and are recharged at cost.

Establishments carrying out hiring of horses and new dog breeding establishments will always require veterinary inspection.
