- 1. All Memorials are to be erected as per the Cemetery Regulations & current NAMM Code of Working Practice
- 2. No work should commence until the application is approved and the Permit issued.

- 3. No Memorials are permitted on unpurchased graves.
- The grave number **MUST** be inscribed on the reverse of the Memorial. 4.
- 5. No Memorials are to be erected or re-erected until at least six months after the last internment to allow for settlement (This does not apply to plots with a concrete headstone plinth)
- No element of a memorial is permitted to overhang the centre line on F plot or the front edge 6. of the concrete beam foundation, on all plots with a concrete headstone plinth.
- All memorials must be erected centrally to the grave. The concrete plinths have a central 7. marker.
- 8. All memorials are to be placed in/on the headstone channel unless agreed in writing by the Burial Officer.
