## **BYELAWS**

with respect to Knackers' Yards..

## BYELAWS

made under Section 58 (1) (b) of the Food and Drugs Act, 1938, by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Folkestone, acting by the Council, requiring persons licensed under the Act to keep Knackers' Yards to keep records, and produce them when required.

1. Every person licensed under the Food and Drugs Act, 1938, to keep a knacker's yard shall –

- (a) keep records of all animals brought into the knacker's yard showing legibly with regard to each animal received the following particulars:
  - i. the date of receipt;
  - ii. a description thereof;
  - iii. the name and address of the person from whom it is received;
  - iv. the date when it is killed and the weight of the head, carcase and offals; and
  - v. the date when, and the names and addresses of the persons to whom, the different parts of it were disposed of, and the weight of each consignment.
- (b) produce such records at all reasonable times on being required to do so by the Medical Officers of Health or any Sanitary Inspector.

2. Every person who shall offend against the foregoing byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a line not exceeding Five Pounds.
