of the BOROUGH OF LYDD and for the prevention of nuisances, made by the Council of the Borough of LYDD in pursuance of Section 249 of the Local Government Act 1933, at a meeting of the Council held on the FIRST day of MARCH 1948.

NOISY CONDUCT IN THE STREETS

If any person in a street or public place makes any loud and continuous noise to the annoyance of residents or passengers and continues to do so after being requested by any resident or constable to desist, such person shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five pounds.
