## **BYELAW**

made under Section 82 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, by the District Council of Shepway with respect to the placing of fish-hooks on the seashore.

- (1) No person shall between the first day of April and the thirtieth day of September, inclusive in any year, place or wilfully leave on the section of foreshore between The Grand Redoubt, Hythe and the Pilot Public House, Lydd-on-Sea any fish-hook, metal stake or similar article in such a position as to be likely to cause injury to any person using the seashore.
- (2) **Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20.**
