We contact you to formally object to the above scheme proceeding.

This highway was built for a very good reason that still needs to be upheld and not altered for the circumstances proposed

The road has proved over many years an ideal link between the natural greenery on one side and the sea on the other. It provides a valuable amenity and access for all of the general public on foot or by vehicle that will be diminished and lost by this scheme

The re-routing of the road will upset a very important part of the Hythe Military Canal which should be maintained as naturally as possible without any interference

There is regular and increasing traffic using the A259 because of the growth in the development of the area and this scheme takes away the relief capacity provided by this part of Princes Parade which is not sensible.

The loss of parking spaces will also cause cause problems and detract from using the area.

Overall the scheme has not been fully and properly assessed on financial, economic social and environmental grounds. There are far too many downsides in all of these aspects which were not given proper consideration, initially and the scheme should not proceed.
