Re Stopping up of Prince's Parade, Hythe NATTRAN/SE/S247/3254.

We wish to add our objections to the above proposed stopping up of a road.

This road is a major route within the district and a essential one used daily for many purposes.

If this were to go ahead our main objections would be

- Any new road would not be operational for many, many months meaning a complete loss of this route and traffic needing to take alternative routes.
- Traffic from a new road will be displaced onto the A259 and this will add to an already busy road.
- If the A259 is closed for any reason emergency services regularly use Prince's Parade...where will they be able to go
