My children have swum at the current Hythe pool for 10 years, a fantastic facility but the pool now needs replacement.

I support relocating to Princess Parade.

I am told there are now objections regarding moving the highway, presumably to frustrate the process, I can't see any merit in these objections as one way or another Princes Parade will join Seabrook Road but in the new proposals a few hundred metres westward.

Whilst Princes Parade is certainly an adequate site my first choice was always a site in Hythe (given proximity of new site to Folkestone Pool and access for those who live on the marsh).

I have heard that Hythe Cricket club is likely to fold over the winter. There is a lot of land on the South Road site, I have suggested in emails to council in the past that the pool could form part of a major Sports Club on the site of South Road Recreation ground where the current cricket/squash pavilion is, parking could be at the old Aldi site (double story) with access by walking across the bridge and a very small amount of traffic via road next to the canal for supplies etc.

A plaza on the car park would be excellent for restaurants and be in the sun, some of the high street could then be rezoned for housing.
