Hi Lauren,

We had discussions internally with our street lighting team to make certain and due to the distances between the calming measures not being great (i.e. a driver would move from light-dark-light-dark etc in quick succession, we need to light the whole route.

We will definitely look at the possibility of off-peak dimming via KCC's led remote control centre if possible, but we can't promise at this stage this as an outcome as the calmed elements will still have to keep a minimum level of illumination (we can't second guess this before the detailed design).

I was at a meeting with FHDC planners and the project team yesterday PM at Folkestone and all seemed to accept this; so I suspect you're perhaps a little behind in terms of time lag of info being passed on.

I think a bit more work was needed to clarify on the light spill from the highway lighting as this was not clear, but I'm sure that will be passed on to the relevant project manager.
