- Wildlife and Ecological issues, the displacement of the current wildlife is not acceptable. This includes several different species, including nesting ground birds.
- II. The houses are not zero carbon, and the construction is not carbon free
- III. There is a lack of initial infrastructure, no programme or a timeframe has been provided to show the continuous development of the infrastructure. The development requires a certain level of initial infrastructure as to not affect the local areas and Towns.
- IV. Transport, it has been noted that there is no agreement with the rail link to stop at Westenhanger. It was noted that the bus link did not show the length of service. The development should consider a park and ride scheme for those looking to attend local Towns. There is not a significant traffic mitigation plans in place.
- V. There is a lack of affordable housing, including affordable rentals for first time buyers.
- VI. There will be a massive impact on Hythe as a Town. There will be increased traffic causing access and egress issues, there will be parking issues then using the Towns amenities. The traffic will affect London Road and Sandling Road, these roads already experience traffic issues. The traffic mitigation plan in place is not significant and will not prevent the issues listed.
- VII. The development is out of character with the local area
- VIII. A briefing should be provided to all Town and Parish Councils who are asked to comment on this application, to allow them the opportunity to ask questions and receive expert advice
- IX. The potential sale of the site to a private developer, meaning loss of control over the development
- X. The lack of consultation with the local residents and their needs being taken into consideration.
