

Factsheet 16 Rough Sleepers and Single Homeless

Some people sleep rough sleep on the streets or elsewhere outside as they do not have access to any temporary or permanent accommodation.

Rough sleeping exists as the most serious form of homelessness and if you are concerned about a person sleeping rough there is a range of places you can refer them to.
