Folkestone to London in just 53 minutes via High Speed 1 rail line

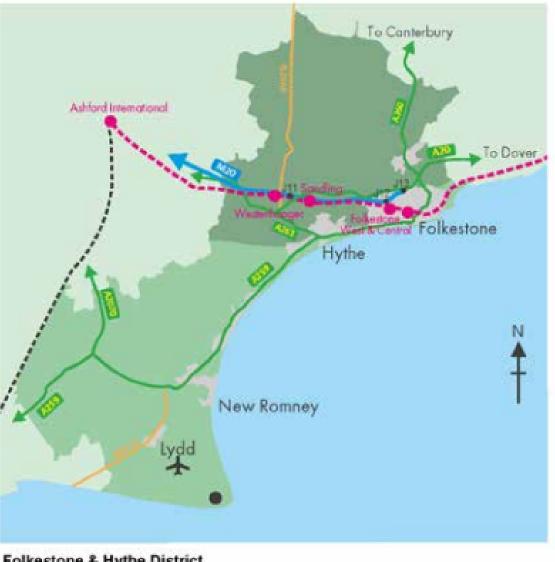
Folkestone to Calais in 35 minutes via Eurotunnel (Le Shuttle)
