

Disabled Adaptations Policy (Summary)

Purpose

- Explains how the Council provides housing adaptations for disabled tenants.
- Aims to support independent living and safety.

What the Council does

- Works with Occupational Therapists to assess needs.
- Provides suitable and cost-effective adaptations.
- Manages budgets and waiting times.

Types of adaptations

- Minor works are completed within shorter timescales.
- Major works may take longer and are prioritised.

Decision making

- Each case is assessed individually.
- Decisions consider cost, practicality, and long-term use.

Other options

- Moving home or external funding may be considered.
- Tenants must get permission for their own works.
