Regulation 16(1) of The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 requires the Council to publish (which must include publication on its website) a statement:

- **that the audit has been concluded**
- **that the statement of accounts has been published**
- **of the rights of inspection conferred in local government electors by section 25 of the Act and the address at which, and the hours during which, those rights may be exercised.**

This notice is in relation to the 2024/25 Statement of Accounts and advises that the audit of the Council's 2024/25 Statement of Accounts has ended and the Council's external auditor, Grant Thornton has issued their Audit Opinion on the 2024/25 Statement of Accounts. The 2024/25 Statement of Accounts were approved by the Council's Chief Financial Officer (s151 officer) and the Audit and Governance Committee on the 29 January 2026.

The external auditor's 2024/25 Audit Opinion, which was issued on the 04 February 2026, is that the Council's 2024/25 Statement of Accounts show a true and fair view and is an unqualified opinion, the highest level of assurance. The audit certificate was issued on 14 July 2026 and is published alongside this notice.
