An objection representation received 12 April and a support representation received 20 April summarised as follows:

Objection:

- Unofficial lorry park been operating for upwards of 2 years.
- Located in a narrow section of the A20 in a very dangerous position.
- Lorries leaving entering the site cannot turn correctly due to narrowness of A20 and holds up traffic.
- Is accident waiting to happen.
- Noisy lorries travel through area at all times of the day and night.
- Refrigerated lorries cannot turn their engines off creating further noise.

Support:

- Lorry parking in Kent is very limited and closure will have detrimental effect on local area with foreign drivers parking in lay-bys
- With proper signage and cooperation, the facility could provide local jobs and income.
- Most lorry drivers are law abiding and do not want to cause any disruption.
