Addendum to agenda item 4 – C/23/52 Proposed on-street parking charges- 15th November 2023

1. INTRODUCTION

This addendum follows an investigation into the possibility of offering free parking for an initial 30 minutes in the proposed on-street pay & display bays in and around shopping streets in Folkestone, Sandgate, Hythe and New Romney before charging applies. Both the cashless parking provider and the P&D machine supplier can offer this. Drivers must either obtain a ticket from the machine and display it or book the free session via RingGo to avoid a penalty charge.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

That recommendation 2 be replaced with the following:

That subject to statutory consultation:

- a. Parking charges be introduced in and around the shopping streets as shown in appendix 1 in Folkestone, Sandgate, Hythe and New Romney from the 1st April 2024.
- b. That the following charges with the minimum stay being 30 minutes and maximum stay 2 hours, all days, 8am-6pm, be applied:
 - Folkestone: free for the first 30 minutes, then £2 per hour, linear per minute
 - Sandgate, Hythe & New Romney: free for the first 30 minutes, then £1.80 per hour, linear per minute
- c. That unlimited waiting for permit holders continue to apply in areas with existing shared use parking.
- d. To authorise capital spend of £70k for the procurement of new pay & display machines, signing and lining.

3. PROPOSALS

That item 2.3 be replaced with:

It is proposed that subject to statutory consultation, the following linear per minute charges with minimum stay of 30 minutes and maximum stay of 2 hours are applied all days, 8am-6pm, from 1st April 2024:

- Folkestone free for the first 30 minutes, then £2 per hour
- Sandgate, Hythe, and New Romney free for the first 30 minutes, then £1.80 per hour

4. FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

That the following be included as item 3.5.

The option to offer the initial 30 minutes free of charge will reduce the potential income from £384,712 to £288,534k on the best-case scenario, and from £230k to £173k on a worst-case scenario. Full details are shown in appendix 1.
