## **NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

Notice is hereby given that SHEPWAY DISTRICT COUNCIL proposes the above Order under sections 32, 35 and 35c of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), having obtained the consent of Kent County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act -

The Order proposes to convert the following car parks into Long Stay chargeable facilities from 1st June 2018:

- Stripes Club, Cheriton Road, Folkestone
- The Lade, Coast Drive Lydd

The following charges will apply 8am-6pm, all days:

Up to 5 hours	£2.00
6 hours+ (all day)	£3.00
The Lade	
Linear per minute charging	
Per hour	£1.20
6 hours+ (all day)	£8.00

The Order also proposes to convert the following car park into a long stay 'permit holders or pay & display' facility from 1st June 2018.

## • Wilberforce Road, Sandgate

Anyone with a valid Zone S resident or business permit will be permitted to use this facility without charge. The following charges will apply to non-permit holders 8am-6pm, all days:

Up to 4 hours	£3.00
All day	£5.00
