Order 2018 (Amendment No 4).

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intend to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The Order proposes to introduce the following restrictions in the roads listed below:

Prohibition of waiting at any time

Roads in Folkestone, **Eversley Way** on both sides for a distance 58 metres from the junction with Coolinge lane and in the turning head. **Hollands Avenue** opposite properties 35 to 42 including turning head. **Ryland Place** On the north side for 10 metres west from the junction with Lennard Road.

Roads in Elham, Pound Lane, Outside no. 18 for a distance of 14m in a northerly direction

Roads in Hawkinge, **Sandpiper Road** On both sides for a distance of 5 metres from the junction with Page Road

Roads in Hythe, **Blackhouse Hill** Both sides, from its junction with Station Road for a distance of 22 metres in northerly direction. **Moyle Tower Road**, on the western side from the junction with South Road for 42.5 metres

Roads in St Mary's Bay, **Grassmere**, from a point 6.6 metres north from the southern kerb line adjacent number 10 New Bridge Way.

Prohibition of stopping on footway or verge

Roads in Folkestone, **Ainsdale Close**, **Invicta Road** both sides, entire length, **Linksway**, both sides from the junction with Linksway Close to the junction with Lucy Avenue, **Lucy Avenue**, from the junction with Linksway to the junctions with Perries Way and William Avenue.

Roads in Dymchurch, **Seabourne Way**, both sides, entire length.Roads in Hawkinge, **Lewis Road**, both sides, entire length. Roads in West Hythe, **West Hythe Road**, both sides from the Royal Military Canal to the boundary between properties 'Leafield' and 'Castle View'.

Stopping places for emergency vehicles only

Folkestone, Court Approach, Opposite Hannover House

Provision for limited waiting disabled persons parking bays

New Romney, Church Road, on the southern side by the Lych Gate

The Order proposes to revoke the following parking restrictions:

Prohibition of waiting at any time

Morrison Road, outside numbers 25 and 27 to the boundary of numbers 31 and 33.
