DECISION:

To provide funding of £1054 to the above project.

Reason for decision:

We have been pleased to provide activities in over 1300 client sessions so far this year, 61% of whom are children and young people. Nearly 50 people have come to us for the first time in 2019 as we are continually looking for new ways to encourage people to try paddling as a way of combatting inactivity and improving fitness levels. In order to continue to provide this service and resource for our community we need to buy new boats and buoyancy aids.
