Name and description of project:

Lympne playing field improvements –

We will spend the grant on new play equipment for Lympne playing field. The item is still to be determined, as we are awaiting details of a special offer items from play equipment companies. This piece of play equipment will be combined with other items purchased from future fund raising to form a new playground for children and young people in Lympne.

DECISION:

To provide funding of £600 to the above project.

Reason for decision:

The play equipment at Lypne Village hall is old and close to being decommissioned. We currently have no outdoor facilities for other members of our village, and would like to make Lypne playing field a village centre with facilities for sport and recreation for people of all ages. We held consultation events in October 2018, and sent a questionnaire to all homes in Lypne in summer 2019. Responses were strongly in favour of redeveloping and improving the equipment on the playing field.
