## Reasons for urgent decision:

The Capital Strategy is a requirement of CIPFA's Prudential Code for Capital Finance in Local Authorities.

Local Authorities are required by regulation to have regard to the Prudential Code when carrying out their duties in England and Wales under Part 1 of the Local Government Act 2003. Paragraph 27 of the 2017 edition of the Code states the prudential indicators for the forthcoming and following years must be set before the beginning of the forthcoming year. The prudential indicators include the setting of the operational boundary and authorised limit for borrowing for the authority.

The report was due for consideration by Cabinet on 19 March, and Full Council on 25 March, but due to the current situation with COVID-19, both meetings were cancelled. Both the Leader and the Chairman of the Council have given their consent for this decision to be made by the Director of Corporate Services, as per paragraph 2.1 in Part 8 of the constitution.
