Report summary: Retrospective application for the erection of a suspended car deck to allow two cars to park on the site.

The Strategic Development Manager explained there was an additional letter received from the applicant and read this to the Chief Planning Officer.

No comments had been received from any Member of the Planning & Licensing Committee.

The Chief Planning Officer considered the existing modern dwelling design along with other development in the locality. He considered that this combined with the planting that is now starting to establish on the structure, on balance, the visual impact is acceptable and not considered to be defendable on appeal.

The Chief Planning Officer requested that all standard conditions be imposed, a condition requiring details of surface water drainage, a condition requiring the submission of a landscaping and maintenance plan and a condition requiring details of lighting to be agreed before any lighting is erected.
