Mobilisation – to replace to existing wheelchairs that are worn and potentially unsafe to use. To provide perspex screening in our vehicles to increase safety of staff, volunteers and passengers.

DECISION:

We are currently providing assistance at the vaccination hubs and many people have arrived without suitable walking aids. Having a wheelchair operated by a trained person, lessens the likelihood of falls, trips and accidents, there by reducing the demand on the NHS. With access to a wheelchair it opens up access to clinics and other appointments at the Day Centre. With perspex screens fitted to our vehicles it is safer for all involved and we will be able to transport more at any one time.
