Name and description of project:

Purchase of community defibrillator and cabinet with spare electrodes in redundant telephone box in centre of Saltwood.

DECISION:

To provide funding of £500 to the above project.

Reason for decision:

Saltwood is 11 miles from the nearest hospital and ambulance station and has no emergency defibrillator equipment. The centre of the village includes a primary school (approx. 220 staff/students) and is used as a transport hub by numerous students from Brockhill Park Academy. It is the location for a village hall used by clubs as well as a pub and a restaurant. BT have given notice that they no longer need the single public telephone box in the centre of Saltwood. This would be a very good site for a community defibrillator. BT are willing to make it available for this purpose. Informally the local planning authority are sympathetic to this proposed change of use.
