8. Folkestone Parks and Pleasure Grounds Charity - Quarter 2 Budget Monitoring 2021/22

9. East Cliff feasibility study / proposals

Members received a presentation from Alastair Clifford, Chief Officer – Operations, who took them through draft proposals for East Cliff, Folkestone Harbour Ward, with the next stage being a full consultation with residents.

Some concerns were raised that a draft plan was already in place but it was noted that this was what a potential project could look like and there would be a full public consultation before scoping any project to take forward. It was also noted that there was no funding in place or authorisation to proceed with anything other than scoping the project.

Members agreed to proceed with the full public consultation early in the new year and report back with the consultation results to the Trustees to decide upon next steps.

- Consultation being developed with 3 local community groups
- Change rhetoric to "public consultation to take place" and remove draft masterplan from website
- Report back consultation results to FPPG considering proposed next steps
