Background

- Following climate declaration for the council "to develop a strategy for Folkestone & Hythe District Council to play a leadership role in community, public and business partnerships for our Carbon Neutral 2030 commitment throughout the district"
- Project proposal for a District-wide Carbon Plan taken to Working Group (25 November 2021)
- Project proposal approved by Cabinet (23 March 2022)

District-wide Carbon Plan – 5 Priority Areas of Focus



Road Transport 33%



Residential 29%



Commercial & Industrial 21%



Other activties (waste, water, food production) 7%



Land Use Absorption 3%



Carbon Innovation Lab

- Proposed to set up a 'Carbon Innovation Lab' a small, informal and inclusive group from key local groups, businesses, academics and members of public
- Objective for the Lab to promote dialogue, work in partnership, be an influencer of change, exchange ideas and best practice



Carbon Innovation Lab

- Officers have built up a database of groups and individuals who may be interested in the Lab
- Rang around contacts to gauge interest in inception meeting
- Invitations sent to 29 people
- Inception meeting held virtually on 13 June



Inception Meeting

- Chaired by the Cabinet Member for the Environment
- 9 people attended the meeting from local businesses, environmental and community groups
- Outlined:
 - The intended role of the CI Lab
 - Some of the decarbonisation projects that the council is working on
- Followed by open discussion and sharing of expertise

Contributors' comments

- Impressed by the work the council is doing, but limited awareness of these achievements
- Difficulty of travelling sustainably in the district
- Key importance of gathering and evidence, analysis and understanding what drives people's behaviours
- Need to have exciting projects to promote or else seen as 'taking away people's cars'
- Need to look at green economy and growing sectors
