

R13-01: Provide cycle parking at the start of the route at Hythe and throughout town centre

R13-02: Opportunity for new segregated cycleway along A261 London Road

R13-03: Widening and access improvements. Carry out lighting assessment and where and if possible improve existing lighting. Improve signposting

R13-04: Add/ update wayfinding signage. Add route information

Route follows National Cycle Network (NCN) route 2 for most of its length

R13-10: Improve transition between coast path and A259 Sandgate Esplanade

R13-13: Opportunity to provide a new bidirectional cycleway along Marine Parade and Lower Sandgate Road

R13-14: Provide new cycle parking at the start of the route at Folkestone Harbour and throughout town centre

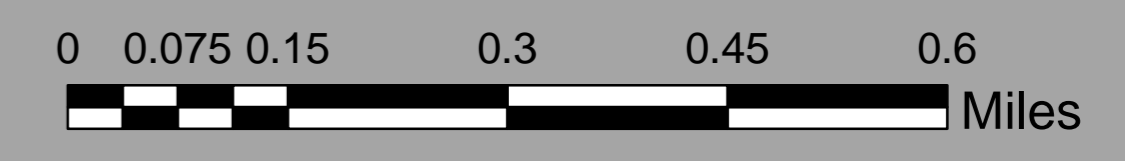
